

Dean's Scholarship

The Dean's Scholarship (DS) is a merit-based scholarship for current or returning undergraduate and graduate students. The scholarship is intended to recognize academic excellence among University College students.

The DS pays for **\$1,000*** toward University College course tuition each semester for one year, as long as the recipient remains in good academic standing and maintains a 3.7 GPA at Washington University. The deadline to apply is **April 1** (fall) or **October 31** (spring). The DS can be combined with other University College scholarships.

*Combined total scholarship and Pell grant awards cannot be greater than tuition.

To be considered for the DS, Undergraduate applicants must:

- Be admitted to a University College undergraduate degree program
- Be working on first undergraduate degree
- Have completed 12 hours of UC coursework prior to the application deadline
- Have a cumulative 3.7 GPA

To be considered for the DS, Graduate applicants must:

- Be admitted to a University College graduate degree program
- Be working on first graduate degree
- Have completed 12 hours of UC coursework prior to the application deadline
- Have a cumulative 3.7 GPA

Note: Washington University employees are not eligible for University College scholarships.
