DECLARING A MINOR

Students may declare a minor field any time before beginning the final semester of study toward a Bachelor of Science.

When you have discovered a field in which you wish to undertake a minor, first consult the online description for your degree program. Normally, a minor consists of a minimum of 15 units, of which at least 3 courses must be on the 300-level or above. Lay out a tentative plan for fitting those courses into your remaining semesters, along with your major requirements and any outstanding distribution requirements.

Regulations governing major fields also apply to minors, e.g. only courses receiving a C- or higher will be applied to the minor. Course work may not “double count” both toward a major and toward a minor, although course work for the minor may fulfill distribution requirements.
