

Community College Merit Scholarship

The Community College Transfer Scholarship (CCMS) is a merit-based scholarship for a recent graduate from a community college with a 3.7 GPA or higher. The scholarship is intended to recognize academic excellence among St. Louis-area community college students who seek to continue their education through University College at Washington University.

The CCMS pays for **\$5,000** toward University College course tuition each semester until graduation, with a seven-year limit, as long as the recipient remains in good academic standing and maintains above a 3.0 GPA at Washington University. One recipient is chosen each year, with the award beginning in the fall. Applicants should apply before the fall scholarship deadline on April 1. Runners-up who are members of Phi Theta Kappa will be considered for the Phi Theta Kappa scholarship.

To be considered for the CCMS, applicants must:

- Apply within one year of graduating from a community college
- Have a minimum 3.7 GPA
- Be admitted into a University College degree program
- Interview

Note: Washington University employees are not eligible for University College scholarships

To apply for the CCMS, remit the following items before April 1:

- University College Scholarship Application
- Essay
- 3 Academic Letters of Recommendation
