

### Graduate Scholarship

The Graduate Scholarship (GS) is a need-based scholarship for University College graduate students working on their first graduate degree. The scholarship is intended to provide aid for students who have financial need so they can meet their educational goals at Washington University.

The Graduate scholarship pays for **\$500 to \$2,000** toward University College course tuition each semester for up to one year, as long as the recipient remains in good academic standing and maintains above a 3.0 GPA at Washington University. The Graduate scholarship can begin in the fall or spring semester. The deadline to apply for fall scholarships is **April 1**; the deadline to apply for spring scholarships is **October 31**. This scholarship can be awarded more than once, however all returning students must reapply by the fall scholarship deadline of April 1 to receive an award for the subsequent academic year.

To be considered for the GS, applicants must:

- Be admitted into a UC graduate degree program
- Demonstrate financial need

Note: Washington University employees are not eligible for University College scholarships

To apply for the GS, remit the following items before the application deadline:

- University College Scholarship Application
- Essay
- Error-free FAFSA
- Evening School Profile
- Most recent tax return (if you are classified as a dependent on your FAFSA, submit your parental federal income tax statement as well)
