

### Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship

The Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship (PTK) is a merit-based scholarship for Phi Theta Kappa members who have attended a St. Louis area community college for at least one year and have a 3.5 GPA or higher. The scholarship is intended to recognize academic excellence among St. Louis-area community college students who seek to continue their education through University College at Washington University.

The PTK pays for **\$3,000** toward University College course tuition each semester for one year, as long as the recipient remains in good academic standing and maintains above a 3.0 GPA at Washington University. Up to three recipients are chosen each year, with the award beginning in the fall and ending the subsequent summer semester. Applicants should apply before the fall scholarship deadline on April 1. The PTK is awarded once.

To be considered for the PTK, applicants must:

- Be a member of Phi Theta Kappa
- Apply within one year of leaving the community college
- Have attended community college for at least one year
- Have a minimum of a 3.5 GPA
- Be admitted into a UC degree program

Note: Washington University employees are not eligible for University College scholarships

To apply for the PTK, remit the following items before April 1:

- University College Scholarship Application
- Essay
- 3 Academic Letters of Recommendation
