Scholarship Policies

1. Scholarship recipients must be admitted to a University College degree program by the application deadline to be considered for a scholarship.
2. Scholarship recipients must remain in good academic standing (placement on probation of any kind warrants the removal of the scholarship).
3. Scholarship awards can be applied only to University College courses that are applicable towards the student's degree program.
4. Scholarship awards cover tuition only. Lab fees, late fees, books, courses in other divisions or other expenses are not covered.
5. If the recipient is eligible for a Pell Grant, the grant will be applied before the scholarship. University College scholarship awards will cover any remaining tuition expenses, up to the scholarship amount.
6. Students may apply for and receive one award.
7. Students can apply for and be awarded the Community College Merit, Phi Theta Kappa, Dean's, and Transition Scholarships only once.
8. Students can apply for and be awarded the Career and Graduate Scholarships more than once. Once awarded, these scholarships are automatically renewed for up to two subsequent semesters, as long as the student remains eligible. Returning students must reapply by the fall scholarship deadline of April 1 to receive an award for the subsequent academic year. For example:
 - Original Award in Fall: automatically renewed for subsequent spring and summer (if eligible); reapply for subsequent fall
 - Original Award in Spring: automatically renewed for subsequent summer (if eligible); reapply for subsequent fall
9. Scholarship recipients must attain a passing grade in all coursework to remain fully eligible for scholarships in the subsequent semester.
 - Failing a course will jeopardize the student's eligibility for a scholarship in the subsequent semester. Student regains full eligibility only after successfully passing all courses in a given semester.
 - Withdrawing from a course may also impact a student's eligibility for a scholarship in the subsequent semester. Student regains full eligibility only after successfully passing all courses in a given semester.
10. Scholarships are awarded to new students in the fall and spring semesters only. During the summer, University College provides renewal scholarships only to returning students who have already been awarded.
 - Fall Scholarship deadline April 1
 - Spring scholarship deadline October 31
 - Summer scholarship deadline N/A
