

### Transition Fellowship

The Transition Fellowship (TF) is a merit-based scholarship for University College undergraduate and graduate students. The scholarship is intended to encourage adult students who have been absent from the college classroom for at least two years to resume their education.

The Transition Fellowship pays for **\$1,000** toward University College course tuition each semester for up to one year, as long as the recipient remains in good academic standing and maintains above a 2.0 GPA at Washington University. The Transition Fellowship can begin in the fall or spring semester. The deadline to apply for fall scholarships is **April 1**; the deadline to apply for spring scholarships is **October 31**. This scholarship can be awarded once.

To be considered for the TF, applicants must:

- Have at least a two-year absence from the college classroom
- Be admitted into a University College undergraduate degree program

Note: Washington University employees are not eligible for University College scholarships

To apply for the TF, remit the following items by the application deadline:

- University College Scholarship Application
- Essay
- 3 Academic Letters of Recommendation
