## COMPLETION SCHOLARSHIP

The completion scholarship is a need-based scholarship for **current** or **returning undergraduate students**. The scholarship is intended to provide aid for students who have exhausted all financial aid and have less than 12 credits left to graduate.

The completion scholarship pays for University College undergraduate tuition for up to 12 credit hours as long as the recipient remains in good academic standing and maintains a 2.0 GPA at Washington University. The deadline for current or returning students to apply for fall scholarships is **April 1**. The deadline for current and returning students to apply for spring scholarships is **October 31**.

To be considered for the completion scholarship, applicants must:

- Be admitted to a University College undergraduate degree program
- Demonstrate financial need

Note: Washington University employees are not eligible for University College scholarships.

To apply for the completion scholarship, remit the following items before the application deadline:

- University College Scholarship Application
- Completed FAFSA for current academic year
- Evening School Profile
- 250 word minimum essay on how this scholarship would benefit you
