PHI THETA KAPPA SCHOLARSHIP

The Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship (PTK) is a merit-based scholarship for **new undergraduate** students who are Phi Theta Kappa members, have attended a St. Louis area community college for at least one year, and have a 3.5 GPA. The scholarship is intended to recognize academic excellence among St. Louis-area community college students who seek to continue their education through University College at Washington University.

The PTK pays for up to **\$3,500*** toward University College undergraduate course tuition each semester for one year, as long as the recipient remains in good academic standing and maintains a 3.0 GPA at Washington University. Up to three recipients are chosen each year. The deadline for new students to apply for a fall scholarship is **August 15**. The deadline for new students to apply for a spring scholarship is **January 15**. The PTK can be combined with a need-based University College scholarship only.

*Combined total scholarship and Pell Grant awards cannot be greater than tuition.

To be considered for the PTK, applicants must:

- Be a member of Phi Theta Kappa
- Apply within one year of leaving the community college
- Have attended community college for at least one year
- Have a minimum 3.5 GPA
- Be admitted into a University College undergraduate degree program
- Be a New University College student

Note: Washington University employees are not eligible for University College scholarships.
