TRANSFER STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

The Transfer Scholarship (TS) is a merit-based scholarship for **new undergraduate** students who have attended a St. Louis area community college for at least one year and have a 3.0 GPA. The scholarship is intended to recognize academic excellence among St. Louis-area community college students who seek to continue their education through University College at Washington University.

The TS pays for **\$1,000-\$3,500*** toward University College undergraduate course tuition each semester for one year, as long as the recipient remains in good academic standing and maintains a 3.0 GPA at Washington University. The deadline for new students to apply for fall scholarships is **August 15**. The deadline for new students to apply for spring scholarships is **January 15**. The TS can be combined with an undergraduate need-based scholarship only.

* Combined total scholarship and Pell Grant awards cannot be greater than tuition.

To be considered for the TS, applicants must:

- Be admitted to a University College undergraduate degree program
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Be a New University College student

Note: Washington University employees are not eligible for University College scholarships.

- Essay
